OUR UNIVERSITY

The University of Turbat (UoT) is located at Turbat (District Kech) in Mekran Division. The people of the region had always longed for a university nearby. Their dream finally materialized in the shape of an independent University when the academic activities started in the institution in May 2013 as a full-fledged university.

Prior to getting status as a full-fledged University in 2012, it has been remained a HEC Recognized Sub Campus of the University of Balochistan (UoB) from 2009 to 2012.

The University of Turbat Act, 2012 was passed by the Provincial Assembly of Balochistan on 20th June, 2012, assented to by the Honorable Governor Balochistan on 26th in same year, and was notified in the Provincial Gazette on 28th June 2012.

After completion of entire required formalities including submission of feasibility report, visit of the HEC evaluation team, the University of Turbat was recognized by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan as 168th Public Sector University in the country and Second Public Sector General University in Balochistan on 12th March 2014.



The main objective of establishing this university is the provision of better opportunities of quality higher education to the students of entire province, mainly the remote and backward areas of Mekran Division including district of Kech, Panjgur, Gwadar, and neigh-

boring district of Awaran, Kharan and Washuk (which cover around 1/5th of the total area of the province) to bring them at par with the other parts of the province/country in all walks of life. The university has been shifted from rented building to its permanent building situated at M-8 Ginna area in October 2017. The new building comprises all facilities for higher learning including academic blocks, class rooms, lecture theaters, video conference hall, Computer labs, multipurpose hall, Chemistry labs, Cafeteria, Student facilitation Centre, admin blocks, Bachelors Hostels, Central Library, boy's hostel, girl's hostel, residential colony, sport complex, mosque, Model School, Banks and Medical Center. Despite the heavy odds and daunting challenges, University of Turbat is on way to bringing an educational revolution in the domain of higher learning in Mekran Division. The HEC, provincial and Federal Government have ensured to expedite the process of Uplifting of Turbat University near future. Professor Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir and Professor Dr. Abdul Saboor Baloch took over the



boring district of Awaran, Kharan and Washuk (which cover around 1/5th of the total area of the province) to bring them at par with the other parts of the province/country in all walks of life.

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charge as first Vice Chancellor and Pro Vice Chancellor of the University respectively. Within a short span of time Vice chancellor with the support of supremely qualified faculty members and smart working administrative staff enlisted UoT in fast growing institution of higher education in the country.

Before transforming into an independent university three programs (BBA 4 years, BSCS 4 years, B.Com 2years) were in progress in sub campus of UoB but now there are 23 programs in 11 departments including M.Phil./MS in Balochi and Chemistry in UoT.

With around 2500 students and 200 employees, the University of Turbat has been providing quality education and enhancing entrepreneurial skills of the students.

The university is providing financial assistance to its students through Prime Minister's Fee Reimbursement scheme, Balochistan Endowment Fund, HEC Need Based and merit based Scholarship, Kareem Dashti scholarship, Meer Ilahi Bakhsh Scholarship and many other scholarships sponsored by philanthropists.

The passed out graduates and alumni of University are expected to play a vigorous role in the activities of the projects under China Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC) to bring about prosperity in the region.

University of Turbat believes to promote a culture of innovative and entrepreneurial, to foster and integrative thinking among students.

In this short span of time, University of Turbat earned a number of accolades which have been acknowledged by the people from all walks of life in the country.

As many as 60 faculty members and scholars have been sent to different universities of Pakistan and abroad for M.Phil., MS, Ph.D. and MS leading to Ph.D under the Human Resource Development Program (HRD), Aghaz e Haqooq Balochistan Scholarship and other HEC scholarships scheme. Most of them, after completion of their degree have re-joined University and rest of them are expected to rejoin the university very soon. By the year 2020 the number of Ph.D. faculty is expected to raise up-to fifty.

With 80 highly committed faculty members including 12 Ph.D. and 35 M.Phil./MS qualified, University of Turbat has grown to become a research led university, known for the excellence of its teaching, tradition, innovation and academic services being rendered to the people of Mekran, Balochistan and other provinces as well.

University of Turbat organized its 1st convocation in March 2017 which 220 graduates were conferred degrees and 12 position-winning graduates were also awarded gold medals. The management of UoT is planning to hold its 2nd convocation in March 2019.

The University succeeded to hold the meetings of its statutory and other bodies like Syndicate seven times, Academic Council eight times, Finance and Planning Committee eighth times, Academic Council eight time, Advanced Studies and Research Board (ASRB) Six times, selection board seven times, as well as all important meeting of the apex body the Senate three times.

Research and publications have been the defining distinction of the University of Turbat ever since its establishment. Earnest efforts are consistently made to promote a vibrant research culture and provide a favorable environment to both its faculty members and students for exploration and innovative market oriented higher learning.

University of Turbat launched its very own annual Research Journal GIDROSHIA for this specific purpose while IBLC also has initiated its research journal (MEERI) recognized by the HEC.





The Office of Research, Innovation, and Commercialization (ORIC) is striving to establish strong links with industry in order to facilitate the students for seeking internships and getting research projects for ensuring their future bright.

A bi-annual newsletter "KECH NEWS" from main campus and "ZERWAAN NEWS" from Gwadar campus are

another symbol of distinction for the University. Therefore, University of Turbat is enlisted as one of those successful general Universities which have achieved the enviable feat of publishing their Annual Research Journal, Bi-annual Newsletter, Annual Report, Prospectus and Convocation Booklet in such a short span of time. This is truly a big success story for a University in such a far flung and remote area. University of Turbat, being a student centric university, is extending all possible facilities to its students for quality higher learning, research, and extracurricular activities.

A smart video conference Hall has established by HEC to connect the university with national and international institutions of higher learning. Directorate of Information Technology, the backbone of the university, is one of the paramount achievements, connected to Pakistan Education and Research Network (PERN 2) by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan, providing Wifi services to students, faculty members and administrative staff.

Besides seminar libraries in each department, university also has campus library and university public library with more than 40,000 books on different subjects, national and international research journal, publications, periodicals, and newspapers.

Directorate of Public Relations, a career counseling and student affairs cell have been established to help the students to resolve job related issues such as finding work and setting career goals.

The Quality Enhancement Cell (QEC) with the support of Quality Assurance Agency of Higher Education Commission of Pakistan is working effectively according to the needs of modern times in a changing world with the responsibility to ensure quality education with the futuristic mindset, encourage different academic activities, faculty training and development workshop, and preparing self-assessment report of different departments and faculty members. University of Turbat has signed a number of MOUs with leading national and international universities and educational institutions for promotion of higher learning and research skills and to exchange a framework of cooperation and facilities with the signatories.

Institute of Balochi Language & Culture (IBLC)

Introduction

The Institute of Balochi Language and Culture (IBLC) in the University of Turbat was first established as the Department of Balochi Language and Literature in 2013 to cater the needs of the students of Balochi language and literature. Soon after its establishment the department became one of the most popular departments of the University with enrolling more students in its first batch and proved itself to be the center of excellence for the study, teaching and research about Balochi language, history, literature and culture.

Seeing its popularity and feeling the need of time the university administration, on the wishes of the Ex-Chief Minister Balochistan Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch, upgraded the department of Balochi language and literature in the University of Turbat in 2016, to an Institute (Institute of Balochi Language and Culture) and its horizons were widened and broadened to research and work on Baloch history, language, literature, culture, oral traditions and a lot more which particularly pertain to Baloch and its culture.

Apart from offering BS (four years/eight semester) MA (two years/four semesters), and MPhil programs, the Institute is also planning to offer PhD programs shortly. Moreover, the institute is also running a chair attributed to legendary Baloch poet Mulla Fazul, named as 'Mulla Fazul Chair'. The institute is also publishing a research journal 'Meeri' in which the research papers from well-known authors and researchers regarding Balochi language, literature and culture are published in it. Meeri is also recognized research journal from HEC.

The institute, apart from conducting and supervising scholarly and academic works on formation, classification and standardization of Balochi terminologies related to the different aspects of life, is also working on Indexation of Balochi research journals. The Institute has also setup a reference library, established a Museum, a Center for Translation studies & Culture, Oriental and Occidental Language Center, Collection of general Archives, and a Baloch Cultural Exhibition Center are in the pipeline. The Institute is also working on Balochi Music and on preservation of Balochi Oral traditions.

The aim of the institute is to streamline Balochi language, literature, history, and culture with the national and international languages and cultures. Besides, the Institute also aims to sign MoUs with international organizations working on the national and international languages, literatures, and cultures.

Introduction

This department was established since the inception of the University of Balochistan, sub-campus Turbat on 23rd November, 2013. Department initiated two years B.com program from 1st January 2010. Under the supervision of University of Balochistan, campus passed four batches of B.com.

On 18th May, 2013 Prof. Dr Abdul Razzaq Sabir was appointed as first Vice Chancellor of University of Turbat and on the same date the University of Balochistan, sub-campus Turbat was converted into University of Turbat along with its entire assets, liabilities and services. University of Turbat has achieved one its milestones being connected to PERN 2. Pakistan Education & Research Network is the only research and education network of Pakistan which as launched in 2002. The purpose of this national research and

Directorate of Public Relations



In this most communicative and media era it became increasingly important for every Institute/Organization including universities to know what their clients and stakeholders are thinking about them, what they like and dislike, and what concerns and satisfies them.

Historically, the practice of Public Relations unit within universities has been one-way, asymmetrical. In recent years, however, scholars have advocated a strategic approach to University Public Relations that moves beyond media relations and embraces strategic management, two way symmetrical communications.

Most of the Universities had a problem in making liaison with public, media and other stakeholders; therefore they preferred to establish the Directorate or the Unit of Public Relations in the vicinity of the Universities for having strong linkage with all stakeholders and media to improve the positive image of the University in society. In recent years, numerous universities have established Public Relations unit in order to maintain better communication with students, alumni, communities, affiliated and constituent colleges/institutions, public and other stakeholders.

Acknowledging the contemporary dominating role of media in national development, and the increasing importance of the Public Relations unit in educational institutions, it has been decided by the competent authority of UoT to establish Directorate of Public Relations in the institution. Mr. Ijaz Ahmed Baloch has been assigned the charge as first Director of the Directorate of Public Relations, UoT on June 24, 2015. This office directly works under Vice Chancellor's supervision, therefore this office is bound to perform its duties under the auspice, guidance and patronage of the Vice Chancellor.

In the year 2015-18 this directorate proved itself the main publicity arm and publication unit of University. It dealt not only with dissemination of information and news pertaining to the university, and Public Relations, focusing mainly on projection of official policies, academic activities and development programs through issuance of handouts, press releases and maintaining a close liaison with the local media and Cable Television Network, but also managed to publish Bi-annual Newsletter, Annual Report, Prospectus, and other publications. This office worked with a mission to maintain and strengthen university media relationships, publicity and projection of university's curricular and co-curricular activities and responded client's feedback properly.

Photo Desk

Photo Desk will arrange photo coverage of functions and activities of various departments/sections of University for press, university website and social media for publicity and image building of the university. It will also prepare photographs for exhibitions and maintains photo albums.

Press and Publicity Desk

This desk will arrange press conferences and press briefings, and keeps liaison with print & electronic media and Cable TV Network. The press desk will be entrusted with the task of issuing of press releases, photographs and video footages regarding various events conducted at university to local and national media.

Production Desk

Besides coordinating in publishing publicity literature like Calendar, Datebook, Diary, Telephone Directory of university employees and alumni, this desk in collaboration with IT section also helps to publish booklets, brochures, annual report, newsletter, posters, hoardings and other promotional tools from time to time pertaining to important achievements and the campaigns of university. It will also make arrangements for production of short video documentary on achievements, future programs, events organized by the University and challenges face by the University. The arrangement can be made to broadcast such documentary on national electronic media, Cable Television and can be uploaded on University Official Website and on Social Media after the approval of competent authority. It will also ensures video coverage of all functions/programs chaired by the Vice Chancellor/Pro Vice Chancellor.

Advertisement Desk

The Advertisement Desk will offer its services to win the attention of the people toward University of Turbat through advertisements in print, electronic media, local cable TV network and social media. The advertisement desk will facilitate to release university classified advertisements / announcements / public service messages in press and local Cable TV Network on approved rates. In collaboration of IT section and concerned department this desk is responsible to cooperate in designing the text/contents of the advertisement for print.

Library and Exhibition Desk

This Desk will deal with maintaining a small library, wherein Clipped News Items pertaining to UoT, Periodicals, Magazines, Daily Newspapers and Publications of UoT are kept and preserved in safe hands. Institutional Performance Evaluation Review Report of University of Turbat by Quality Assurance Agency (QAA) Pakistan

The visit to UNIVERSITY of TURBAT, Turbat was conducted on Jan 31st 2018 to Feb 2nd 2018 on the basis of eleven IPES standards. Prior to the team visit, the university/institution has prepared University Portfolio Report (UPR) on the guidelines provided by the HEC. This also includes a series of answers to the questions related to each of the eleven standards. During the visit to the university, the panel physically examined the infrastructural facilities, acquainted itself with the institutional resources and held discussions with the faculty members, administrative officials and students. Recurring Grant

Soon after being recognized by HEC, the University of Turbat started receiving annual recurring grant from HEC w.e.f September, 2014. It received total grant of Rs. 45 (M) during 2014-2015, Rs. 101 (M) during 2015-2016, Rs. 138 (M) during F/Y 2016-2017, during 2017-2018 Rs. 129.555 (M), and for the current F/Y 2018-2019 Rs. 136 (M) has been allocated including Rs. 6.7 (M) for need based scholarships.

Endowment Fund

The former CM of Balochistan Dr. Abdul Malik Baloch had announced during the stone laying ceremony of the UoT Project on 6th Feb, 2014 to provide funds for establishment of UoT's endowment funds. Accordingly, an amount of Rs. 50 (M) was received from GoB during last quarter of F/Y 2013-2014 which was invested in three years' term deposit in NBP @ 11.75% p.a after obtaining comparative rates of interest through open and transparent bidding.

After maturity the original amount plus 50% of the profit were invested in Habib Bank Limited(H-BL)@ 10.70 for one year.

This fund was meant for investment in the long term deposit/securities in order to meet long term financial needs of the University and the profit/interest will be utilized for providing scholarships and other benefits to the students.

Grant in aid

The honorable Governor Balochistan/ Chancellor PSU's of Balochistan has very kindly granted a total amount of Rs. 109.81 (M) during the last four years i.e. 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018 as Grant in Aid which have been spent for the heads and purposes prescribed by the Government of Balochistan.

Future Plans

The Management of University of Turbat is determined to make the University financially health and stable in the long run. To achieve this objective, it aims in enhancing its revenue earning capacity on the one hand and strengthening financial discipline and governance on the other hand. The university has already started the process of affiliating all the colleges and other institutions within its jurisdiction as well as to register Private Candidates. It is expected that this will bring in significant revenues during subsequent years. There are a number of other plans in pipeline aimed at making the organization financially self-sustaining.

Moreover, the office aims to be the best research center of the region and build and sustain productive relationship and linkages with the governmental agencies, international academic and governmental agencies, private sectors, industries, elementary and secondary schools and colleges. Further, innovation and production of ideas, patents and innovation would remain as the core values of the office.

In pursuit of this mission the Office of Research has the responsibility of guaranteeing that all research programs and policies reflect the core values of academic freedom, professional integrity and ethical conduct and full compliance with all policies, legal requirements and operational standards of the university.

FINANCIAL AID OFFICE



The University of Turbat, Financial Aid office is dealing with the Need Based and Merit Based Scholarships for the students of University of Turbat. In this process the office is currently dealing with five Scholarship programs including HEC Need Based Scholarship, French Need Based Scholarship, Pakistan Bait-UI- Maal, Baluchistan Education Endowment Fund and Philanthropist. Under The HEC Need Based Scholarship program, the office has provided 54 Scholarship to the Batch 2015-2018, 69 Scholarships to the batch 2016-2019, 9 Scholarship to the Batch 2017-2020 and 37 Scholarship to the Batch 2018 –2021. These Scholarships were provided to the bachelor and master students of various disciplines within the UoT. Moreover, Under HEC- French Need Based Scholarship, 16 Scholarships were provided to the undergraduate students of various disciplines. Under the Pakistan Bait- UI- Maal Scholarship, 50 Scholarship were provided to the master and undergraduate students of various disciplines of UoT and under Baluchistan Education Endowment Fund 77 scholarship awarded to students of various disciplines.

Additionally a new scholarship is created under the head of Karim Dashti Scholarship (KDS), where an initial amount of Rs.1 million has sought for the purpose.

Prime Minister's Fee Reimbursement Scheme for Less Developed Areas

The Scheme was approved in June 2012 by the Government and was initially designed to reimburse tuition fees and on and off mandatory charges for the students of Balochistan, FATA and Gilgit Baltistan. In 2013, it has been made an integral part of Prime Minister's Youth Program. The scope of the Program has been increased since then and now 114 districts of Pakistan are eligible under the Scheme.

Financial Coverage of the Scheme:

1. Actual Tuition Fee (of Masters , MS/MPhil and PhD programs)
2. On and Off Mandatory charges which includes Registration Fee/Enrollment Fee, Admission fee (For new admissions only), Examination Fee, Library charges(non-refundable), Laboratory charges, Research related academic activities only.
3. Non study related heads like transport fee, hostel fee, Sports fee, Endowment Fund, Equipment Fee, Health Fee or Any Refundable dues will not be paid.

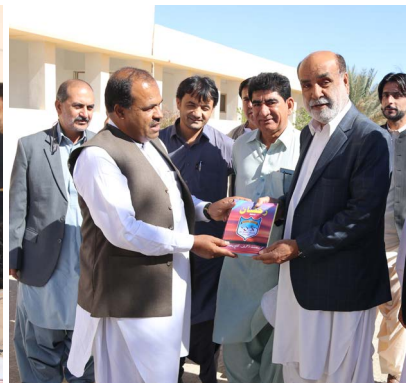

Students arrange Farewell program in UoT

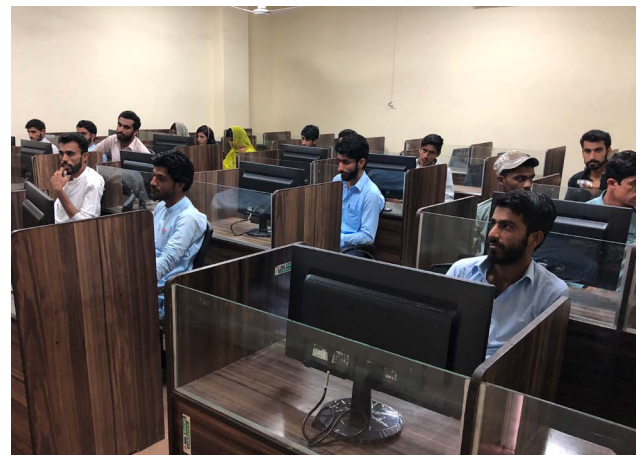

The books and reading material available in Library support not only every course in the curriculum i.e. Management Sciences, Computer Science, Commerce, Economic, Political Science, English, and Balochi but also include selected stock of general books and materials on History, Anthropology, Islamic Studies, Geography, Archeology, Regional Studies, languages and literature, published by National and International publishers, Library also has subscribed national and international periodicals, publications, newspapers in English, Urdu and Balochi etc. The whole library system at campus library is being computerized and HEC has been asked to provide facilities for online library service which will be available through a network after the completion of the computerization process. The library also has a reasonable number of internationally published Research Journals



Student Hostels

University of Turbat has students from all over Makran that are enrolled in different programs. Some of the students are not resident of Turbat City. For them, UoT has 3 buildings for hostels, which include 2 for boys and 1 for girls, with all basic needs and comfortable in the campus. Each hostel has its own cook and mess, which is partially supported by the University. There are security guards on each hostel, and a female warden for the girl's hostel.



Campus Cafeteria

The University of Turbat at its City Campus has a well-furnished Cafeteria having fast food and tea shop facilities only for campus students and faculty members.

The Cafeteria has seating for more than 30 students at a time with separate seats for male and female students or faculty members. Photocopy facility is provided in the shops within the campus for facilitating students of UoT, especially females.



University Transportation

The University of Turbat has four buses, one coaster and 2 Vans to provide pick and drop facility to the students living in Turbat city and suburbs. The University also provides transport facility to its students for field work and annual picnics once a year to each department on need basis. The study tours for students are partly financed by the students and supplemented by the University, subject to availability of funds. UoT also has an ambulance for the students and faculties. University of Turbat Gwadar Campus



Introduction

The idea of establishment of a Sub Campus of Turbat University in Gwadar was originated by the Vice Chancellor University of Turbat Prof Dr Abdul Razzaq Sabir in 2015. A team of expert led by the Vice Chancellor prepared and tabled the proposal of establishment of Gwadar Campus in Syndicate in its third meeting as item No.6 held on May 30, 2015 for approval. The Finance and Planning Committee also endorsed and approved the idea of establishment of Gwadar Campus in its fourth meeting as item No.5 held on June 29, 2015 at Karachi.

After thorough discussion and approval of recommendation of establishment of Gwadar Campus from different meetings and statutory bodies the proposal was presented in the apex statutory body of UoT the Senate during its first meeting chaired by Ex-Governor Balochistan/ Chancellor PSUs Muhammadad Khan Achakzai, held on March 30, 2016 at University Public Library Turbat.

In pursuance of principle approval by Ex- Governor Balochistan, the Higher Education Commission Pakistan issued a notification on July 4, 2016 to set up a Sub Campus of University of Turbat at CPEC central city Gwadar.

The Sub-Campus of University of Turbat was established at Gwadar under the Umbrella Project of “Establishment of Sub Campuses of Public Sector Universities at district level (phase-1)”.

The Sub Campus in CPEC central city Gwadar has been transformed into a full fledged university of Gwadar at par with international standard. The CM Jam Kamal led Balochistan Assembly approved the University of Gwadar Bill 31 of 2018 in its session continued from 29th October to 3rd November, 2018. The bill was presented by the minister for Information and Higher Education Mr. Zahoor Ahmed Buledi. 500 acres land at Shabi near Pishukan has been transferred in favor of University of Gwadar. Earlier VC UoT Prof Dr. Abdul Razzaq Sabir along with Director Gwadar Campus Mr. Ijaz Ahmed, on 7th September 2018 has given a detailed briefing to the CM Balochistan regarding Gwadar University Project. During meetings VC UoT, on 10th October and 16th November 2018 at Governor House Quetta, the Governor Balochistan/ Chancellor PSUs Honorable Justice (R) Amanullah Khan Yasinzai assured to take every possible measures for development of Gwadar Campus and establishment of University of Gwadar.

The admissions in four BS Programs were announced on August 31, 2016 while applications for the position of Lecturer were invited on October 18, 2016.

Initially, BS Programs in BBA, BSIT, B.Ed (Hons), ADE and B.Com are approved by the statutory bodies for Gwadar Campus and classes started from January 16, 2017. On the request of HEC, A team of experts led by the VC UoT Prof Dr Abdul Razzaq Sabir has prepared the Charter and PC-1 of University of Gwadar and submitted the same at concerned forum for approval.

The team was also comprised on Director IBLC and then UoT PVC Dr Abdul Saboor Baloch, Ex-PD of UoT Manzoor Ahmed Baloch, DF/Registrar Ghulam Farooq Baloch, Muhammad Hayat, Director Gwadar Campus/DPR Ijaz Ahmed and chairpersons of various department.

It is highly anticipated that in the leadership of Vice Chancellor prof Dr Abdul Razzaq Sabir and the efforts put in by energetic and talented faculty members and Campus Administration, the graduates of Gwadar Campus are expected to play a pivotal role in all spheres of life. Under the banner of Turbat University, Gwadar Campus is working on a plan to introduce a culture of innovation and entrepreneurial ship to foster integrative thinking among students so that they could contribute in the projects under CPEC for the economic prosperity of Pakistan in general and Balochistan in particular.

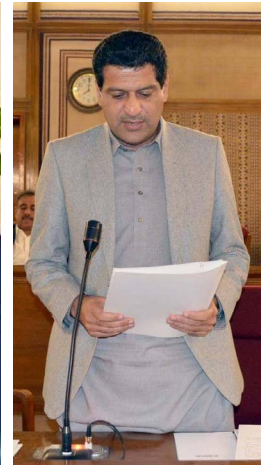
Director UoT Gwadar Campus participated in MARSEW-18

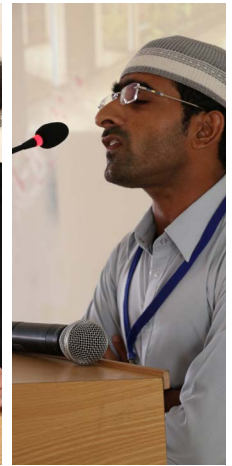
