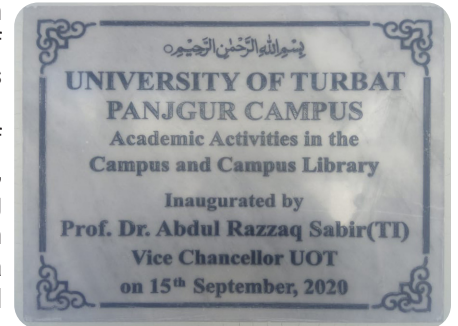


## VC UoT inaugurates academic activities in Panjgur Campus
